

Accessing Data for Grantees and Subgrantees (login required)

Grantees and subgrantees can use LASSIE data to answer questions about institutional characteristics, LSA program characteristics, institutional supports, reported outcomes, service-learning activities and technical assistance needs and strengths.

As a grantee or a subgrantee you can access three types of reports, and view your (and if applicable, your subgrantees') data.

Once you have *logged in*, you can access the data by clicking on the **View Reports** link.

Basic Report

The Basic Report provides key data on individuals and partner organizations that participate in Learn and Serve-supported service learning activities. For further details around these participants, or other information reported through LASSIE, see the Comprehensive Reports.
